### Enduring Fence Project for Delaware City

Although the Smithsonian Traveling Exhibition, *Between Fences* has moved on, an enduring, cooperative fence will remain in Delaware City's waterfront park to serve as a reminder. The fence project was coordinated by local preservationist Debbie Martin and Delaware City blacksmith, Kerry Rhoads. Their creative talents brought together 21 artists/blacksmiths, Paul's Pointing, a historic masonry company, and the local Challenge Program, a private, non-profit organization for out-of-school youth. They forged and crafted steel rods, laid brick and split wood. And with helping hands of many community residents, they erected an enduring and memorable work of community art. The fence will endure as will the dialogue on how neighbors and nations "divide and protect, offend and defend, the boundaries they build."
